This is an organization which has as its sole mission to support the Shepard Garden & Arts Center. The Friends have been approached by the Center's Board of Directors for help. The Center was created as a place for patrons of the arts to meet together. The City of Sacramento supported the Center by paying for employees to monitor the Center, gas, lights, electric bills, etc. Two years ago, the City restructured their support of the Center. It gave all financial responsibility including payroll and operations to the Center. The City used to be responsible for running the Center; now that responsibility rests solely on those who use the Center. The only income the Center receives is from rent and Fall and Spring Sales. Last fiscal year, the Center's expenses exceeded income; the Center's modest reserve account is currently used to make up the difference.

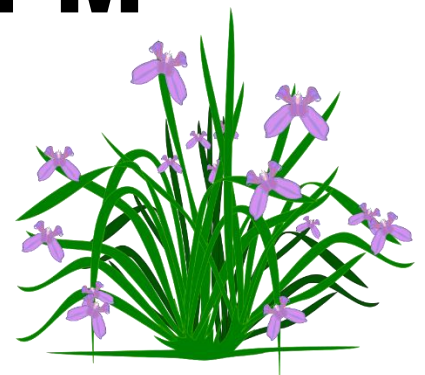

The Sacramento Bromeliad and Carnivorous Plant Society welcomes the public to its 47th annual show and plant sale. Hundreds of colorful bromeliads and unusual carnivorous plants will be on display and for sale. The show will be held at the Garden and Arts Center, 3330 McKinley Boulevard, Sacramento on Saturday and Sunday, July 22nd and 23rd, from 10am to 4pm each day. Admission and parking are free.

Bromeliads are decorative and easy to grow house or patio plants. Many can be grown outside all year round in Sacramento with some winter protection. A number of the carnivorous plant families thrive both in Sacramento's full sun and winter cold with little care, other than constant water at their feet.

There will be educational displays on carnivorous plants, and members of the Society will be on hand to answer questions and provide tips on growing both families of plants. Hundreds of plants from both families will be on sale at very reasonable prices. Most of the sale plants cannot be found in nurseries and will provide a colorful and easy-to-grow addition to your garden or plant collection.

CLEAN-UP DAY

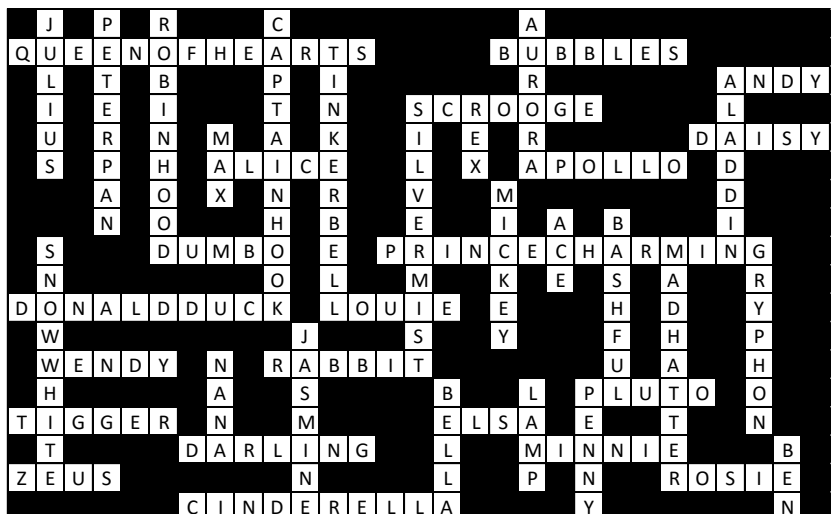

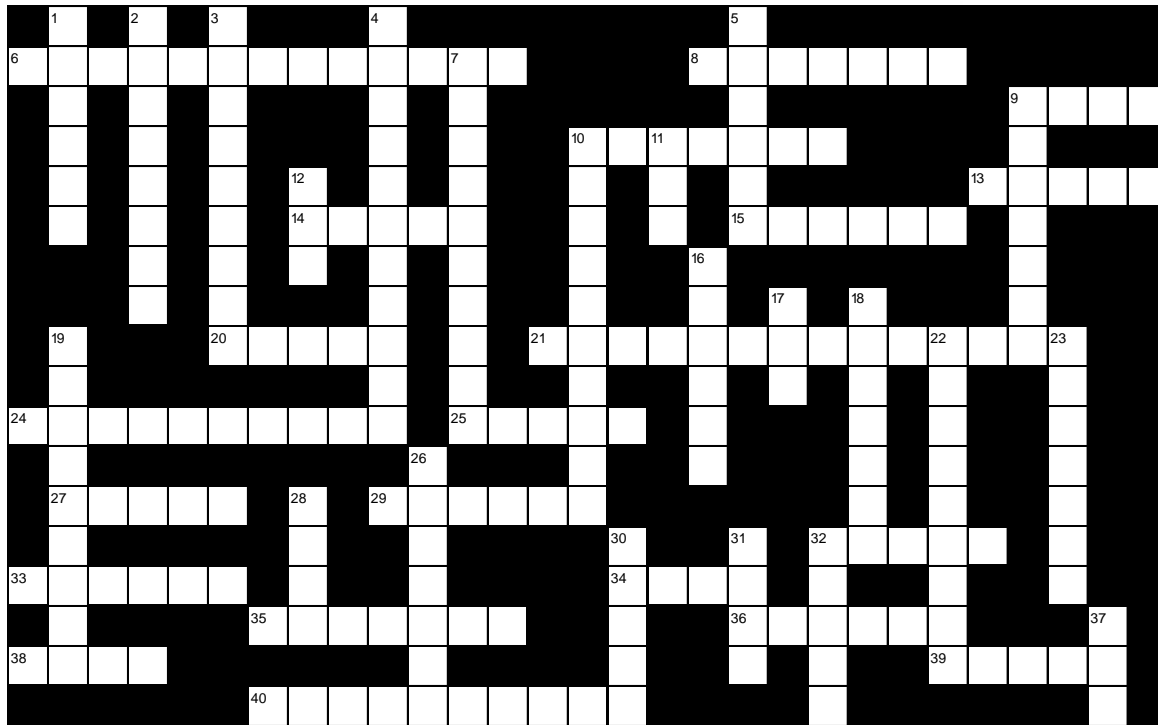
