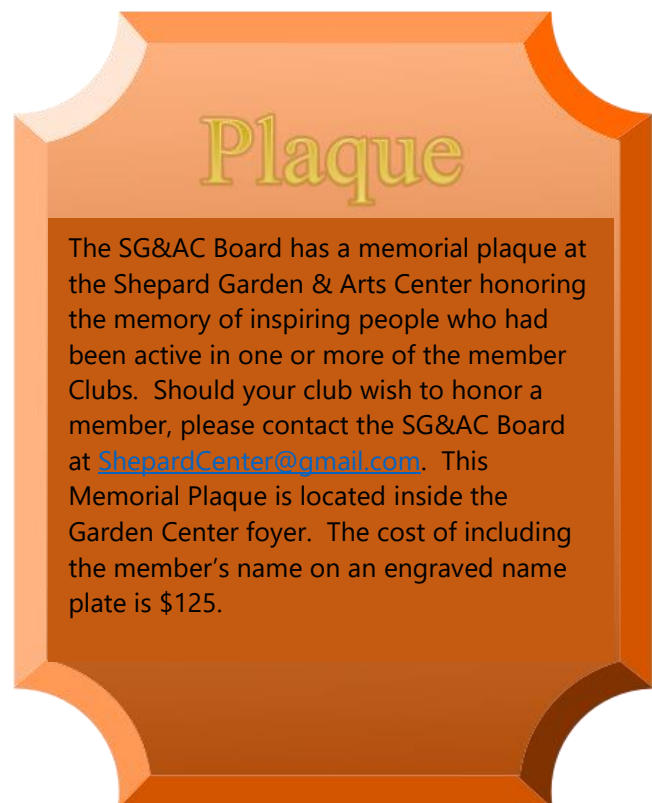
Dear fellow club members,
